APERITIFS

CHARTREUSE(25ml) YELLOW - £4.00 / GREEN - £4.50

This specialty liqueur was first produced at the Chartreuse Monastery in the Alps and is made with more than 130 herbal extracts. To this day, monks from the Order of Chartreuse are the only ones entrusted with its secret recipe and is made only in the mountains under the supervision of monks. Once touted as a health elixir, there are two kinds of chartreuse - (green and yellow). Green chartreuse has a stronger flavor and higher alcohol content(55%). Yellow Chartreuse (40%), which has a milder and sweeter flavor and aroma.

PASTIS- PERNOD (50ml) £2.95

Often considered the national apéro, Pastis is a spirit native to the Provence-Côte d'Azur region in southern France and is an anise-based liqueur. Pernod is mixed with select herbs; Ricard is less herbal and with a milder anise flavor. Pastis is drunk by mixing it with three parts cool water, which turns the drink a milky color and releases the flavors in the liqueur.

PINEAU DES CHARENTES (50ml) £3.90

The Charentes, a department in central France named after the Charente river, is famous for Cognac and Pineau. Pineau was invented when a winemaker in the Charentes poured grape must accidentally into a barrel containing cognac. It is a sweet strong wine

NOILLY PRAT (50ml) £2.95

Noilly Prat was originally a dry, straw-hued vermouth from Marseillan, in the Hérault département of southern France. Joseph Noilly, a herbalist, developed the first formula in 1813. It was the first example of a dry vermouth .

SANGRIA 0.5L CARAFE - £6.90 / 1L - £11.90 / 1.5L - £17.90

Pitcher of Sangria is a wine punch . It consists of merlot , chopped fruit, a sweetener, and a small amount of added brandy and our Barman sweet secret.

QUINTA DO NOVAL LBV PORT (50ml) £3.50

Port is one of the great dessert wines of world from the Duro valley in northern Portugal. Can be served chilled as an aperitif.

MARTINI (ROSSO/BIANCO/EXTRA DRY) (50ml) £2.50

There is a beauty in MARTINI like no other drink. A true Italian icon created by over 140 years of dedication and passion. It is the charismatic drink of the truly stylish who know it as...the world's most beautiful drink.

CAMPARI (50ml) £4.50

Campari is a bitter Italian Aperitif made according to a secret recipe originally developed in 1860 by Gaspare Campari in Milan. Campari is the result of a unique blend of aromatic herbs mellowed in selected spirit.

PEDRO XIMÉNEZ (50ml) £3.50

intensely sweet, dark, dessert sherry. It is made by drying the grapes under the hot Spanish sun, concentrating the sweetness, which are then used to create a thick, black liquid with a strong taste of raisins and molasses that is fortified and aged in solera. We recommend to be served with Cured Meats and a Cheese Board.

DIGESTIVES

GODET VS (25ml) £2.90

This cognac has a pwerful nose of fresh vanilla which is accentuated with notes of old leather.

GODET VSOP (25ml) £3.90

This cognac offers a light woody, floral nose, tinged with hazelnuts and peach jam. Its persistence in the mouth makes it very pleasant and easy to drink.

GODET FOLLET BLANCHE EPICURE (25ml) £4.90

Tender and voluptuous, delicate and elegant, this cognac delightfully illustrates the original flavour of cognac, as the kings of France used to like it.

GODET GASTRONOME 14YR (25ml) £5.20

It is a one of its kind, an exceptional Eau-de-vie that was created by Augustin Godet in 1838. The first intention was to create the perfect Eaux de Vie for food lovers, hence its appellation Gastronome. It appeared later on that on top of being extremely dry and smooth, this cognac is very elegant and fruity. The distillation and ageing secrets of the Gastronome Fine Champagne have since remained one of the best kept secret of the Godet family.

GODET ANTARCTICA (25ml) £4.90

In March 2008, Jean-Jacques Godet, embarked on a sailing trip to Antartica accompanied by 10 crew members. They landed on the Antarctic continent, at 70 degrees south of the equator. Never has such a small yacht succeeded in docking at such a level, a record was broken. In honor of the accomplishment Cognac Godet has created a unique cognac inspired by the purity and beauty of Antarctica. It is a cognac that was once itself endangered. Created from the Folle Blanche, it is a vine that only narrowly survived extinction from the Phylloxera of 1870.

GODET PEARADISE (25ml) £3.90

Unique blend of Pear liqueur with old cognac giving birth to a drink balancing the sweetness of the liqueur and the character and strength of the cognac.

WHISKY

HIGHLAND - TOMATIN 12yr (25ml) £3.50

A complex, fresh and airy bouquet which contains rich malt and fruity aromas with a hint of peatiness.

SPEYSIDE - TOMINTOUL 10yr (25ml) £3.50

Tomintoul is Scotlands second highest village. This expression has a soft gentle nose with notes of honey, more robust with a lively tingle on the palate

LOWLAND - SPRINGBANK 10yr (25ml) £4.50

(near Campbeltown in south Scotland) Salty nose, with mild peat and old socks puts the locality in Campbeltown, but the burst of flavours sets this whisky apart. Spice, apricots, and almonds.

ISLAND - LEDAIG 10yr (25ml) £3.90

(a smokey version of Tobermory) The nose is profoundly peaty, sweet and full, with notes of butter and smoked fish. Medicinal enough to suggest an Islay. Bold, yet sweet on the rounded palate, with iodine, soft peat and heather. Developing spices. The finish is medium to long, with pepper, ginger, liquorice and peat.
